The Board of Directors of the Amarillo USBC shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the Amarillo USBC Tournament.

Each woman will be responsible for reporting her correct tournament average to the team captain. All individuals placing in the money positions will have averages verified. If average recorded on entry is lower than verified average, average will be raised. If average is higher than verified average, average will remain as entered. Prize fund will be returned 100% - at least 1 for 5 entries will be paid.

**Check– in 30 minutes before time to bowl. Make all substitutions at least one hour before, if possible. Note: Practice time will start at 2:00pm.**

**ENTRIES AND FULL REMITTANCE MUST BE MAILED BY MIDNIGHT MARCH 18, 2026.**

The entrants whose names appears hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Amarillo USBC, its officers & agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if & when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or causes relating thereto or resulting there from fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Amarillo USBC.

**This Tournament Sanctioned by USBC**

Total Score only will be checked. Team captains & individuals participating in doubles & singles should watch the automatic scores carefully. Please see that scores are recorded correctly.

Only bowlers will be permitted in the immediate bowling area. Children must be kept above step level at all times.

Team Captains: Please read carefully before completing entry form and retain for future reference.

**Averages:**

**RULING A:** The entering average shall be the bowler's highest average of 21 or more games in the Amarillo USBC yearbook of the previous winter league season (2024-2025). No USBC Youth averages allowed.

**RULING B:** If no current Amarillo USBC yearbook average, entering average shall be the bowler's highest average of 21 or more games in any Amarillo USBC sanctioned league as of February 28, 2026.

**RULING C:** 10 pin rule 319a2 will apply. Average as of February 28, 2026 is determining average.

**Awards**

**FIRST PLACE TEAM:** Four individual awards.

**TIES:** In the case of a tie for first place in any event, the teams or individuals tying shall be declared co-champions of the event & duplicate awards shall be awarded. Prize monies shall be combined & divided equally.

**WOMEN'S CHAMPION:** Scratch All Events Award.

**HIGH SCRATCH SERIES & GAME:** Awards.

**RUBY WAGNER HIGH GAME AWARD:** Special award given to the bowler 55 years and over who bowls the highest scratch game in the tournament.

**GRANDMOTHER AWARD:** Special award given to the qualified grandmother who bowls the highest scratch game in the tournament, excluding the Ruby Wagner High Game Award.

**ENTRANTS**

1. Only Amarillo USBC women members in good standings are eligible to bowl.
2. A member may participate more than once in the team event. Not more than 2 players on one team may place more than once in the prize list in the team event.
3. Entrants may enter doubles & singles event only once. However a bowler may bowl doubles only but may not bowl singles only. Doubles will be bowled first, then Singles. No lane swap.
4. A bowler's first team event score counts toward her all events score.
5. Any member arriving late will be permitted to bowl providing a substitute has not started in her place. Her score will count beginning with the frame then being bowled. **NO SCORE WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.**
6. Any starting bowler completing one frame may not be replaced except for an emergency at the discretion of the tournament directors.

**PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR MEMBERS ARE AWARE OF DRESS CODE:**

**ENTRANTS ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR SUITABLE ATTIRE WHEN PARTICIPATING IN THE TOURNAMENT** (except for medical reasons). Short sleeved shirts, walking shorts, skirts, capris, or slacks are preferred. **UNSUITABLE ATTIRE:** tank tops, halter tops, short shorts, or short skirts (if a bowler's fingers are below the hemline, the shorts, skirts, skorts, are considered too short and not suitable), excessively torn or unclean jeans, shirts, or t-shirts with offensive language or pictures. **VIOLATIONS:** entrants will be required to change to suitable attire. Entrants who refuse to wear suitable attire will not be allowed to bowl. **TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to refuse participation without recourse to any one deemed to be inappropriately attired. Inappropriate behavior while participating in the tournament will be considered grounds for disqualification.
